RESTON CAMPGROUND

PURPOSE

To establish rates and regulations for the Reston Campground.

POLICY

The Reston Campground is open seasonally from the second Friday in May – the last weekend in September annually, dates subject to change based on weather conditions. The Reston LUD committee will provide the oversight, budget and staffing with the support of the Council.

The Recreation & Facility Manager and Reston LUD Supervisor will provide daily supervision and scheduling.

BOOKING PROCEDURE

Campground reservations open annually to the general public on the first Wednesday in April.

Campers participating in swimming lessons can make early reservations with their session fee beginning as early as the Friday before the lessons start and ending on the Sunday after the lessons finish.

All bookings are recorded in the Camp Reservations Canada website and must be paid in advance.

Daily Rates

15 amp & Water service sites \$25.00 per night

30 amp, Water & Sewer sites \$45.00 per night

All rates include GST. A \$5.00 registration fee is added to each booking.

Cancellation Policy

There are no refunds for inclement weather, late arrivals, or early departures.

Reservations can be cancelled with a full refund, less the \$5.00 registration fee, if cancelled 4 or more days before the arrival date. If the cancellation occurs 3 days or less before the arrival date, the fees are refunded except for the first night's camping fee and registration fee. No-shows will not be refunded.

Cancellations must be requested to the Municipal office during regular business hours to be processed.

The Reston LUD committee will consider requests for refunds because of a medical reason. These requests must be received in writing.

CAMPGROUND RULES & REGULATIONS

1. **Check in: 2:00 p.m. Check out: 12:00 p.m.**
Campers who are late leaving without prior arrangements will be charged for an additional night.
2. Quiet time is from 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
3. Reston Lake & RM of Pipestone Spray Park: children under 12 are not permitted to use the facilities without supervision. Rules are posted on site, please review prior to using the facilities.
4. Consumption of alcohol out in the open is prohibited. Liquor is prohibited on roads, in washrooms, cook shelters, picnic sites, Reston Lake beach, RM of Pipestone Spray Park or any other public area. Public drunkenness and rowdiness will not be tolerated and will result in police action and immediate eviction without refund.
5. Smoking is prohibited in the washroom facility.
6. Campsites are only guaranteed for camping nights that are paid for.
7. Liquid and solid waste must be disposed of in the receptacles provided. Pouring waste water on open ground or in sump holes dug beneath trailers is prohibited. A sewer dump station is available for your use.
8. No children under 18 may camp in a site by themselves. Parents are responsible for their children and any damages they may cause.
9. Only 2 vehicles per site. All vehicles must be parked on designated gravel areas or in parking spaces. Overflow parking is available near the Spray Park. All vehicles must be operable and licensed. Speed limit in the campground is 10 km/hour
10. Only one camper or RV and one tent OR two tents per site are allowed. Maximum 2 units per site.
11. Unsightly sites will not be tolerated. Please keep your site clean and free of garbage. Garbage cans are available throughout the campground. Please do not litter.
12. Do not damage, cut or remove trees or bushes from campsites. Any damage done is an offence and can be charged.
13. No fireworks, sparklers or caps at the campsite.
14. Obey restrictions on fires. Fires may be limited or prohibited at certain times.
15. Only build fires in the fire rings provided for that purpose. Firewood is provided as part of your camping fee. Firewood must be small enough to fit inside the fire ring. Do not put garbage in

fire pits. Do not start fires with gasoline or camping fuel. Keep flammable materials away from campfires. Be sure your campfire is completely extinguished before leaving your site or going to sleep at night. You are responsible for keeping fires under control.

16. Any foul or abusive language or threatening behaviour towards our staff will not be tolerated. Violation of this will result in expulsion from the campground without refund.
