




DENNIS COUNTY PLANNING DISTRICT

- You are **required** to obtain a Development/Building permit for the following:
- Farm buildings over 6500 ft<sup>2</sup>
  - Farm buildings under 6500 ft<sup>2</sup> including bins (development permit only)
  - Excavation
  - Construction, reconstruction, alteration
  - Removing, relocating, or adding to any structure
  - Changing the use of lands or buildings
  - Beginning the use of vacant lands or buildings
- DON'T FORGET!**
- All buildings and structures must comply with Municipal Zoning By-laws and any other By-laws or requirements of any other Government Department.
- You **do not require** a Development/Building for the following:
- General maintenance & repairs which do not increase the size or increase/decrease the structural load
  - Lighting, flag poles, water wells, temporary signs
  - Unenclosed patios
  - Buildings under 100 ft<sup>2</sup> provided they do not create a hazard

Dennis County Planning District issues Development permits while the Office of Fire Commissioner issues the Building permit.
