Reston & District Library

The library is located at $220 - 4^{\text{th}}$ Street in Reston. Our library is free for people living within the RM of Pipestone and RM of Two Borders. People from outside the two municipalities pay a \$20 annual fee.

Available at our library:

Adult fiction, non-fiction, audio books, biographies, large print and reference material. Children to teen in fiction and non-fiction. **Coming soon:** CELA; Center for Equitable Library Access one-disk audio for persons with print disabilities.

Free Libby App

Patrons can sign up for the free libby app, which will enable them to read or listen to stories on their e-device or cell phone. Books available from children to adult books in


