Cecil & Helen Brownlee Scholarship

In 2010, Helen Brownlee and Family established a scholarship with the Reston & Area Foundation. This fund, established on behalf of the now late Helen and Cecil Brownlee whom had farmed in the Sinclair district is their way of giving back to the area, although family no longer resides there.

- Attendance may commence in the year of the award or may be deferred for one year
- Proof of registration and attendance must be provided prior to payment

Criteria

- Open to all graduating students of Fort La Bosse Schools, with preference given to the Cromer area students first (please specify if you are from Cromer)

- students attending a post-secondary institution both in person or virtually are eligible to apply
- Attendance may commence in the year of the award or may be deferred for one year

Criteria

- All graduating students of Reston School from the Reston or Sinclair areas who are descendants of a veteran or auxiliary member must have a relative/ancestor who has served in the Canadian/Allied Army, preference will be given to the applicant with the highest grades
- Students attending a post-secondary institution both in person or virtually are eligible to apply
- Attendance may commence in the year of the award or may be deferred for one year
- Proof of registration and attendance must be provided prior to payment

Pipestone Legion Scholarship

Criteria

- All graduating students of Reston School from the Pipestone, Belleview, or Findlay areas who are descendants of a veteran or auxiliary member must have a relative/ancestor who has served in the Canadian/Allied Army, preference will be given to the applicant with the highest grades.
- students attending a post-secondary institution both in person or virtually are eligible to apply
- Attendance may commence in the year of the award or may be deferred for one year
- Proof of registration and attendance must be provided prior to payment

Coraleigh Henuset Memorial Bursary

Criteria

- Open to all graduating students of Reston School
- candidates must be of satisfactory academic standard
