And Whereas Stantec Engineering has recommended accepting the tender of H. Baudry Construction 1980 Ltd. in the amount of \$535,186.00 less the removal of item A10 Canal Gates, in the amount of \$50,000.00;

And Further Be It Resolved the Municipal Cost be covered by 25% Municipal Infrastructure Fund and 75% Reston LUD."
